# Devotional: Protecting Your Heart Starts With Wisdom

#### Every strong relationship is built on a foundation of healthy boundaries.

#### Devotional: Truth and Love Go Hand in Hand

#### Devotional: Balancing Love and Self-Care God's Way

#### Devotional: Courage to Say No in Love

Sometimes, the hardest boundary to set is saying no. Matthew 5:37 encourages simple and clear speech — yes or no — without over-explaining or wavering under pressure. Saying no doesn't make you unloving; it shows respect for yourself and others.

God's Spirit equips us with power, love, and self-discipline (2 Timothy 1:7). Through Him, we can confidently set limits in relationships knowing we are not alone or weak. Fear has no place when the Lord is our light and salvation (Psalm 27:1).

Practice saying no when necessary to preserve your peace and God's calling on your life. Trust that saying no with love honors God and helps others understand your boundaries clearly.

Today, embrace the courage God provides to set firm boundaries with grace.
