Devotional: Discovering Your Value in God's Perfect Creation

God's creation is an amazing display of His power, creativity, and love. From the vast galaxies to the tiniest flower, everything was made with intention and care. Imagine the world before humans existed—peaceful and perfect, where all things reflected God's goodness. This shows us how deeply God values order, beauty, and life.

Day 2: 🍑 The Fall: When Things Changed

Devotional: Understanding the Impact of Sin and God's Mercy

Everything changed when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. What was once perfect became broken because sin entered the world. This story can feel heavy, but it helps us understand why there is pain, struggle, and distance from God in life.

As teens, you know how choices have consequences. Sometimes it's tempting to do what feels right in the moment, even if it's against God's way. The fall shows us what happens when we trust ourselves more than our loving Creator.

But remember, this isn't the end of the story. The fall explains why we need a Savior. It also reveals God's justice and mercy—He can forgive and restore when we turn back to Him. Reflect on how sin affects your own life and how God's grace offers hope beyond mistakes.

You are not alone in this struggle. God understands and wants to help you choose the right path. His love is bigger than sin, and He welcomes you to come to Him with honesty and faith.

Teach me to rely on Your love and grace every day. *I am grateful that Your love never gives up on me.* Amen.

John 3:16 NIV - "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

Supporting Scriptures

- Ephesians 2:8-9 NIV "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God."
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"







Devotional: Embracing New Life Through Jesus' Love

God's story ends—and begins anew—with redemption through Jesus Christ. Even though sin separated us from God, His great love provided a way back through Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. This gift is available to everyone, including you.

Right now, you might be facing pressures, doubts, or questions about your future and faith. Jesus offers hope and a fresh start no matter what has happened in the past. When you believe in Him, you become a new creation —a person deeply loved and fully accepted by God.

Living with Jesus means walking in freedom, joy, and purpose. It means trusting God's plan for your life and embracing His love daily. You are invited into a personal relationship that transforms and renews from the inside out.

Take time today to reflect on Jesus' sacrifice and what it means to you. If you haven't yet, consider opening your heart to His love and becoming part of God's family. The big story of the Bible shows that God's greatest desire is to be with you forever.

3.	Reflect on what it means to live as a new creation in Christ.
