Devotional: Marvel at God's Creation and Power

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."
- Isaiah 41:10 "Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."







Devotional: Trust God's Power to Bring Peace

Life as a teen can sometimes feel like a stormy sea—full of fears, pressures, and uncertainties. In Mark 4, we read how Jesus calmed the storm with just a word. He showed His authority over nature and demonstrated that no situation is beyond His control.

When you feel overwhelmed or afraid, remember Jesus' power to bring peace to chaos. God is your refuge, your strength, and His presence surrounds you even in the darkest storms.

Trusting God doesn't mean storms won't come; it means you don't have to face them alone or without hope. God's power can calm the fears inside your heart and give you a peace that passes understanding.

This day, invite God into your "stormy" moments. Speak to Him with faith and watch how His power transforms your anxiety into calm.







Reflect and Apply

1.	What are some 'storms' you are currently facing in your life?
	How can Jesus' authority over the sea and storms encourage you during tough times?
	In what ways can you rely more on God when you feel anxious or overwhelmed?







Journaling Prompts

1.	Write about a difficult situation where you sensed God's peace or presence.
2.	List scriptures that bring you comfort when life feels stormy.
3.	Reflect on what it means to you that God is your refuge and strength.







Prayer for Today

Lord Jesus, thank You for Your power to calm the storms in my life. When I feel anxious or overwhelmed, help me remember that You are in control and that Your peace can still my heart. Teach me to trust You fully, knowing You walk with me through every trial. I surrender my fears and ask for Your strength to face each day with courage. In Your powerful name, Amen.

Supporting Scriptures

- 2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."
- Ephesians 3:20 "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine."







Devotional: Experience God's Power to Change You

God's power is not just displayed in creation or miracles—it works deeply within us to transform our hearts and minds. Romans 12:2 challenges us not to follow the patterns of the world but to allow God to renew our thinking and shape us into His image.

As a teen, you face many influences that might pull you away from God's best. But God's power through the Holy Spirit helps you resist conformity and grow in His grace. Even in your weaknesses, His power shines brightest, as Paul reminds us in 2 Corinthians 12:9.

Imagine living each day empowered by God to make choices that honor Him, to love deeply, and to become the person He created you to be. God can do immeasurably more than you imagine—if you open your heart to His transforming power.

Take this day to invite God to change you from the inside out and trust that His mighty power is at work in your life.

Journaling Prompts

Describe a personal change you want to see and how you can invite God's power into it.
Write about a time when God's strength helped you during a weak moment.
Reflect on what it means to live differently from the patterns of this world.







Prayer for Today

Father, thank You for Your power that transforms lives. Help me not to conform to the ways of the world but to be renewed in my mind and heart. Strengthen me when I feel weak and help me lean on Your grace daily. I pray that Your power would work mightily in me so I can live as a reflection of Your love and truth. In Jesus' name, Amen.
