Devotional: Trusting God Beyond What We See

The snake represented imminent harm, but God's protection transcended natural expectations. Paul's quick shaking off the snake and remaining unharmed is a profound demonstration of divine protection that defies logic and human understanding.

In ministry, problems often look bigger than our abilities, threats more severe than what we can handle. Yet God calls us to trust His supernatural safeguarding. Rather than succumbing to fear, we are invited to lean into faith that God's power is greater than any danger.

This teaches us that sometimes protection is not about avoiding every difficulty but about walking through them unharmed because of God's sustaining power. Reflect on moments when God's protection exceeded your understanding and strengthened your confidence.

3.	Reflect on what hope ministry gives you during hard times.






