Your Verse

Psalm 72:4 - 'May he defend the afflicted among the people and save the children of the needy; may he crush the oppressor.'

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 9:9 'The Lord is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.'
- Isaiah 1:17 'Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed.'







Day 1: ① God's Just Protector

Devotional: God's Heart for Justice and Protection

God's justice safeguards the vulnerable. Psalm 72:4 captures a heartfelt plea for the king—representing God's righteous rule—to protect those who are weak and oppressed. - Matthew 11:28 'Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.'







Devotional: God's Tender Care in Our Distress

- Romans 8:38-39 'Nothing can separate us from the love of God.'
