Devotional: Resting Under God's Protective Wings

Your Verse

Isaiah 41:10 – "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Supporting Scriptures

- John 8:12 "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life."
- Psalm 27:1 "The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?"







Devotional: Trusting God's Strength over Fear and Violence

Devotional: Receiving God's Protection as the Oppressed Woman

Devotional: Embracing God's Peace in Violent Times

Devotional: Courageously Trusting God's Protection

Devotional: Embracing God's Delight and Protection
