# Grace Revealed: Jesus Anointed by a Sinful Woman



Explore 21 days of grace as Jesus honors the broken and silences the self-righteous through a powerful act of love and forgiveness.





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#### Introduction

Welcome to a transformative 21-day Bible study exploring grace in action through the story of Jesus anointed by a sinful woman. In this study, we dive deep into the heart of Jesus' ministry, seeing how He honors the broken and silences the self-righteous with compassion and forgiveness.

This encounter, recorded in Luke 7:36–50, reveals the radical nature of Jesus' love. The woman, despite her past, approaches Jesus with a heart full of repentance and love. She anoints Him, a powerful gesture symbolizing her faith and gratitude. Jesus does not reject her; instead, He acknowledges her faith and offers forgiveness, showing that grace reaches those whom society often shuns.

Throughout the next 21 days, we'll journey through Scripture to understand what it means to be broken, forgiven, and loved unconditionally. We will contrast the attitudes of the sinful woman and the Pharisees, learning how Jesus' grace breaks barriers of judgment and invites all into a restored relationship with God.

As you reflect on these passages and devotions, consider your own need for grace and your response to grace offered by Jesus. May this study deepen your faith, encourage humility, and inspire you to extend grace to others, just as Jesus has shown it to us.







Get ready to watch grace in action and be transformed by the love of Christ that honors the broken and silences the self-righteous.

#### Devotional: Grace Meets Brokenness Head-On

Grace meets us where we are — broken, messy, and often ashamed. In Luke 7, we meet a woman known for her sinful past, yet she approaches Jesus boldly, pouring out her heart and anointing His feet. This act of humility contrasts sharply with the judgmental spirit of the Pharisee hosting Jesus.

Her tears symbolize repentance and faith, her perfume an extravagant offering of love. Jesus honors her despite society's scorn, showing that no sin is too great for His grace. This initial encounter invites us into a deeper understanding: grace is not earned; it is freely given to those who come in humility.

Reflect today on your own struggles to receive grace. How might Jesus be inviting you to approach Him with open hands, trusting in His unfailing love?

Day 2: W The Power of Repentance

#### Devotional: Repentance Opens the Door to Grace

Repentance is the key that unlocks the door of grace. The Pharisee in Luke 7 judges the woman harshly instead of seeing her sincere repentance. This attitude blinds him to the healing power Jesus offers.

The woman's tears and actions demonstrate a heart turned away from sin, embracing forgiveness. Repentance involves not only regret but a genuine turning toward God—a change of heart and mind. Jesus honors this, highlighting that our standing before God depends not on our past but on a heart willing to be transformed.

Are you ready to lay down your defenses and come before God with a repentant heart? Consider what repentance means for your own journey toward grace.

#### Devotional: Worship from a Grateful Heart

Extravagant worship is not about the cost but the heart behind it. The woman's act of pouring expensive perfume on Jesus' feet was culturally shocking yet deeply meaningful. It reflected her deep love and gratitude for the forgiveness she received.

In contrast, the Pharisee's failure to offer even basic hospitality highlighted his coldness. Jesus uses this moment to teach that sincere worship and love come from hearts transformed by grace—not obligation or status.

Consider your own expressions of worship. How can you offer your time, gifts, and love to Jesus with the same extravagance despite life's challenges or past mistakes?

Jesus challenges such attitudes by honoring the woman's faith and humility. He teaches that God's grace is not reserved for the self-righteous but is poured out abundantly on the broken and repentant.

Examine your heart today for any judgments you hold. How can you choose grace over condemnation?

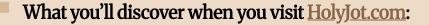




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
