Paul's exhortation in 1 Thessalonians to "pray continually" points to a lifestyle of constant communication with God. As grandparents, adopting this posture models dependence on God and teaches your family the value of prayer.

The fruit of the Spirit listed in Galatians reflects qualities that form a mature believer. When you exhibit these traits, grandchildren see faith lived out authentically.

Titus highlights the special role older women have to teach and model godliness; similarly, older men hold the same responsibility by example. Your day-to-day attitudes and responses impart powerful lessons on integrity and faithfulness.

Ask God to show you areas for growth so your life mirrors Christ clearly.
