Consider how faith accompanied by thankfulness creates an unshakable bond between us and God. Faith is trusting God's promises and goodness even when circumstances are tough. Gratitude is a compelling witness that draws others to God. Matthew 5:16 reminds us that our thankful lives reflect God's goodness and inspire others to glorify Him. Expressing gratitude openly becomes part of our testimony.

The one leper who returned set an example that pointed others to Jesus. When our faith is marked by thankfulness, it shines like light in the darkness and becomes a powerful tool for sharing hope.

Today, think about how your gratitude can serve as a witness and encourage those around you to seek God.
