#### Your Verse

Psalm 34:18 NIV - "The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- 2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."
- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."







#### Devotional: God's Nearness in Our Brokenness

Chronic pain can feel isolating and overwhelming, especially for veterans who have carried burdens unseen. Psalm 34:18 reminds us that **God is intimately close to the brokenhearted**. He does not distance Himself from pain but draws near to those who are crushed in spirit.

Veterans may feel forgotten or weary, but God's promise is sure: He is with us in every moment of suffering. Rather than suppressing pain, we are invited to turn toward God, finding comfort in His presence. The Apostle Paul's struggle with his "thorn" showed that even in weakness, God's power is most evident. #### Your Verse

Isaiah 40:29 NIV - "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 73:26 "My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever."
- Philippians 4:13 "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."







#### Devotional: Divine Strength in Our Weakness

Living with chronic pain often leaves us feeling drained physically and emotionally. Yet, God promises to provide strength when we are weary and empower the weak (Isaiah 40:29). This divine strength is not just physical vigor but deep, sustaining power that carries us through difficult days.

Veterans, especially, who have encountered extreme demands, can find solace knowing God's power is freshly available each morning. The psalmist declares that even when the body fails, God is our enduring strength and portion.

Choosing gratitude today means embracing the reality that God's strength is bigger than pain and limitations. Whatever you face, His power is accessible and sufficient, urging you to lean fully on Him and give thanks for this supernatural resource that never runs dry.

#### Devotional: Embracing the Peace Christ Offers

Chronic pain often stirs fear, anxiety, and restlessness. Yet Jesus offers a peace unlike any the world can give—a peace that calms troubled hearts and removes fear. This peace is not dependent on circumstances but rooted in His presence and power.

# Devotional: Strength and Encouragement in Community

#### Devotional: Hope Strengthens Our Perseverance

Enduring chronic pain requires more than physical strength—it takes persistent hope. Romans teaches that suffering cultivates perseverance, which builds character and ultimately hope that never disappoints.

Veterans who have weathered long trials are called not only to endure but to hold fast to hope, the confident expectation that God is at work for our good. This hope energizes gratitude even when the road is tough.

Consider how hope has carried you so far and how gratitude can deepen your endurance. Each moment of pain refines your character and strengthens your testimony of God's faithfulness.
