Day 1: **B** The Foundation of Gratitude

1 Thessalonians 5:18 – "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 100:4 "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name."
- Colossians 3:17 "And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."







Day 1: **//** The Foundation of Gratitude

Devotional: Gratitude as the Ministry Foundation

Gratitude begins with recognizing God's will for us as followers of Christ. In ministry, it's vital to see thankfulness as a foundation rather than an occasional feeling. Paul tells the Thessalonians to "give thanks in all circumstances," which means praise and gratitude are not dependent on our situations but on who God is.

Why is this powerful for ministry? Because the nature of service often comes with challenges, fatigue, and unseen sacrifices. Yet, when our hearts are anchored in gratitude, we serve with a joyful spirit regardless of hardships. Psalm 100 reminds us to come before God with thanksgiving, anchoring our ministry not in our strength but in His presence.

Moreover, as Colossians 3 instructs, everything we do – words, actions, and ministry efforts – becomes an act of worship when undergirded by thanksgiving to God. Gratitude thus transforms ordinary tasks into holy offerings.

Reflect today on how gratitude is foundational in your ministry service. Gratitude is not merely a reaction but a deliberate positioning of the heart. It honors God and fuels our service with joy and perseverance.

Day 2: O Gratitude Amid Challenges

Devotional: Praise and Thanks in Every Trial

Ministry is not without difficulties—yet gratitude provides an anchor through every challenge. Paul's encouragement to the Philippians instructs believers to approach God in prayer "with thanksgiving" even in anxious moments. This act of faith, offering gratitude alongside requests, reshapes our hearts to trust in God's sovereign care.

How do we cultivate gratitude in hardship? James invites us to consider trials as opportunities to develop perseverance. When we choose gratitude amid struggles, we open ourselves to God's refining work. Psalm 34 expresses a commitment to praise at all times, which models an unwavering gratitude that sustains us.

For those in ministry, hardships can be overwhelming—difficult people, fatigue, or feeling unseen. Yet, by coupling prayer with thanksgiving, we remind ourselves of God's faithfulness and invite His peace. Gratitude does not deny challenges but acknowledges God's greater power and purpose in them.

Today, try to pray with thanksgiving even over the difficulties you face. Let this mindset renew your strength and deepen your call to serve joyfully without fear or discouragement.

Your Verse

Romans 12:11–12 – "Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

Supporting Scriptures

- Hebrews 13:15 "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name."
- Matthew 25:40 "Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."







Devotional: Grateful Service Fuels Ministry Zeal

Ministry thrives when our hearts serve with zeal powered by gratitude. Paul's instruction in Romans emphasizes maintaining passion in serving the Lord fueled by joy, patience, and faithfulness. Gratitude naturally nurtures this spiritual fervor because it focuses on God's goodness rather than exhaustion or discouragement.

Why is this vital in ministry? Serving others with a thankful heart offers God a continual sacrifice of praise, as Hebrews explains. It transforms service from routine duty to worshipful offering. More importantly, Jesus reminds us in Matthew that every act of kindness to those in need is ultimately service to Him.

When we serve in ministry, remembering the privilege and blessing it is to be God's hands and feet helps sustain us. Gratitude helps us see beyond challenges to the eternal impact of our labor. It also keeps our motivation pure — not seeking recognition but honoring God through joyful giving.

Take time today to reflect on how gratitude inspires your ministry zeal and renews your joy. Consider how serving with thanksgiving impacts those you serve and glorifies God.

Devotional: Gratitude Strengthens Ministry Community

Paul's joy in thanking God for the church in Corinth illustrates how recognizing God's grace in others builds unity and encouragement. Gratitude binds a community together, fostering love and mutual support.

Why does this matter? Ministry is seldom solitary; it thrives in community. Ephesians calls us to continually give thanks to God for everything, teaching us to acknowledge His work in and through those around us. When we express gratitude within the body of Christ, it spurs one another toward love and good deeds.

Hebrews warns against neglecting fellowship, showing that consistent connection with others in gratitude fuels perseverance and hope. Celebrating God's grace in our ministry partners and community strengthens the whole.

Today, reflect on your ministry relationships. How can you cultivate gratitude for those who serve alongside you? Consider how expressing thanks, encouragement, and love can build a thriving ministry community.

Devotional: Commit to a Life Marked by Gratitude

Gratitude is not just a momentary feeling but a lifelong lifestyle especially vital in ministry. Psalm 136 calls us to remember God's enduring love continually, urging us to give thanks because He is eternally good. This persistent thankfulness reflects the heart of ministry – a heart anchored in God's unchanging character and gifts.

The apostle Paul echoes this wonder as he praises God for the "indescribable gift" of salvation and grace. Gratitude shapes our understanding of every blessing, inspiring deeper devotion and joy. The story of the ten healed lepers in Luke illustrates living gratitude in action. Only one returned to thank Jesus, exemplifying the rarity but blessing of a grateful heart. Ministry calls us to be like that one healed leper – always returning to Jesus with thanks and praise.

As you close this study, commit to growing a life marked by continual thankfulness in ministry. Let gratitude shape your character, guide your service, and inspire those you lead.
