Devotional: Joy in the Midst of Challenges

Why does the Bible tell us to consider trials as pure joy? At first glance, this sounds impossible. No one enjoys difficulties, especially when they bring pain or confusion. But God sees the bigger picture. These moments test and refine our faith like a silversmith purifies precious metals. Each challenge pushes us to rely less on ourselves and more on God's strength.

When you face hard times, remember that God is working through those moments. Instead of resisting or becoming discouraged, try to view them as opportunities for growth. It might mean learning patience when you're frustrated, showing kindness when you feel misunderstood, or trusting God's plan when you feel lost. Every trial is a chance to build perseverance, which leads to stronger character and hope.

Ask yourself: How can I find joy in my struggles today? How might God be shaping me through them? This mindset shift turns hardships into spiritual victories.

Day 2: **①** Trusting God Through Hard Times

Devotional: Complete Trust Builds Strong Faith

Trusting God isn't always easy, especially when life feels uncertain or unfair. It's tempting to rely solely on our own understanding or try to control every situation. But God calls us to a different path—a path of surrender and faith.

When you choose to trust God wholeheartedly, you invite Him to guide your steps. Even when you can't see the full picture, He knows the way and promises to direct you. Trust is like a muscle; it grows stronger the more you exercise it through daily decisions to believe in God's goodness and promises.

Hard times will come, but they don't have to shake your faith. You can lean into God's love and provision, knowing He is close and ready to help. Remember, trusting God doesn't mean problems disappear — but it means you have a steady anchor amid life's storms.

Your Verse

- Galatians 6:9 "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."







Day 3: 🔥 Developing Perseverance That Lasts

Devotional: Fixing Our Eyes on Jesus

Perseverance is the ability to keep going even when the journey feels long or difficult. The Christian life is described as a race, and like any race, success depends on endurance and focus.

Hebrews encourages us to run this race with perseverance by keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus — the ultimate example of faith and endurance. When teens face discouragement, failure, or peer pressure, remembering Jesus's strength and purpose can renew motivation to press forward.

Developing perseverance means not giving up when challenges arise but trusting God to help you finish well. It also means encouraging others who may be struggling on their own races.

Think about your own 'race' in life. What helps you stay focused on Jesus? How can you grow in perseverance this week?
