Day 2: 6 Identifying the Roots of Lust

#### Devotional: See and Address Hidden Temptations

Day 3: N Armor of Self-Control

#### Devotional: Walking Daily in Spirit-Led Self-Control

**Self-control is a fruit of the Spirit and a key weapon against lust.** Galatians 5 emphasizes that this quality is not born from human effort alone but through the Spirit's work in us.

Discipline is required to keep lust and temptation at bay in marriage. Paul's analogy of an athlete disciplining the body (1 Corinthians 9:27) reminds us of the intentional nature of this fight. Without self-control, a person's defenses crumble like a city without walls (Proverbs 25:28).

Couples can pray together for the Spirit's strength to resist impulses that harm intimacy. Building habits like accountability, avoiding triggers, and fostering healthy communication guard this self-control. This strengthens the marriage and moves the couple toward holiness and unity.

Consider the armor parts you need to put on today—truth, righteousness, the gospel, faith, salvation, and the Word—to protect your marriage effectively from lust's attack.
