Greed can feel like a trap, appealing and yet destructive. Paul warns in 1 Timothy 6:9 about the dangers of wanting to get rich quickly. This desire often leads to temptation and foolish pursuits that destroy our spiritual lives.

*Proverbs 1:10–15* advises us not to give in to sinful enticements, while *James 1:14–15* explains that temptation arises from our own desires. Growth requires vigilance—a proactive effort to protect our souls.

Think about the traps you may have faced or currently face related to money. Some come as subtle thoughts or feelings, others as external pressures or opportunities. Recognizing these dangers is essential.

The remedy is rooted in resisting temptation and seeking God's wisdom and strength. Ask God to reveal hidden areas of greed and to empower you to choose godliness over gain. Growth isn't just about avoidance but about cultivating hearts aligned with God's truth.
