



Devotional: Spotting Wolves: Guarding Your Heart

False prophets often present themselves with enticing words and seem trustworthy, but their intentions are deceptive. Jesus warned us to be discerning, recognizing that not everyone who speaks in God's name truly represents Him. They come in "sheep's clothing" but inwardly are ravenous wolves.

False prophets may twist Scriptures, promote selfish agendas, or teach heresies that deviate from biblical truth. Peter affirms this, revealing their greed and destructive nature. Jeremiah also cautions the people not to follow prophetic words offering false hope but to seek the true voice of God.

Discernment is essential. It's not enough to accept teachings simply because they are eloquent or popular. We must test all teachings against Scripture and seek the Holy Spirit's guidance.

Ask God to help you identify falsehood and to cling to His truth even when deception is subtle and attractive.



Devotional: Fruit Reveals the Truth Behind the Teaching

Jesus teaches us to evaluate teachings and teachers by their fruit—their actions, character, and the results of their ministry. Just as a thornbush cannot produce grapes, false teachers cannot produce godly fruit.

True spiritual fruit reflects the character of Christ: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. These qualities demonstrate the Holy Spirit's work in a believer's life, contrasting sharply with the chaos and division false teachings often cause.

Testing the spirits is an active process—discerning whether the teaching aligns with God's Spirit and Word or leads believers into error. This demands prayer, reliance on the Holy Spirit, and knowledge of Scripture.

Examine carefully the impact of teachings and teachers on your heart and community. Are they bearing godly fruit or sowing confusion and division?

False prophets and deceivers often attempt to legitimize themselves by performing signs and wonders beyond normal human ability. Jesus teaches that these miracles, though impressive, can be counterfeit and intended to lead people astray.

Signs and wonders alone do not confirm godliness or truth. The enemy can mimic miraculous acts to deceive even the elect if possible. Paul also warns of the lawless one who uses counterfeit miracles to sway many.

Therefore, spiritual discernment requires more than amazement at signs; it requires testing the source and fruit of the message and person. God's truth is consistent, humble, and bears lasting fruit.







Be watchful against teachings that push for financial gain, manipulation, or control disguised as spirituality. Seek leaders who model integrity, transparency, and sacrificial love.




