Devotional: Gratitude Transforms Our Hearts

Thanksgiving isn't just a feeling; it's an act of worship. Psalm 100:4 invites us to enter God's presence with thanksgiving and praise. This attitude opens our hearts to celebrate God's goodness regardless of our circumstances.

Paul instructs believers in 1 Thessalonians 5:18 to give thanks in all situations—not just when life is easy. Gratitude anchors us in hope and shifts our perspective toward God's sovereignty. Colossians 3:17 expands this by reminding us that everything we say and do can be an expression of thanks, drawing us closer to God's presence.

This day, let your heart overflow with praise as you consider how gratitude turns ordinary moments into worship and acknowledges God as the source of all blessings.
