Day 1: Finding Comfort in God's Presence

#### Your Verse

Psalm 34:18 – "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."
- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."

#### Devotional: God's Nearness to Heal Your Heart

Heartbreak leaves behind painful wounds, but God's presence brings healing. Psalm 34:18 promises us that the Lord is especially close when our hearts are broken. This is not a distant God but One who draws near to soothe pain and restore hope.

If you feel crushed or overwhelmed, remember that your emotions are seen and valid before God. He does not avoid your tears. Instead, He offers comfort, peace, and rest for your weary soul. The invitation in Matthew 11:28 is to come directly to Him with all your burdens.

Allow yourself to be honest about your feelings and lay them before God daily. Healing begins when you lean into His nearness and trust that His love never fails, even when your heart feels vulnerable.

#### Your Verse

2 Corinthians 5:17 – "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Galatians 2:20 "I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."
- Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works."







Day 2: Benewing Your Identity in Christ

#### Devotional: Embracing Your New Life in Christ Alone

When heartbreak threatens to define you, God's word invites you to embrace a new identity. 2 Corinthians 5:17 assures believers that in Christ we are new creations. The past — including pain or disappointments — does not have the final say about who you are.

Your value is found not in relationship status but in being deeply loved and redeemed by Jesus. Galatians 2:20 reminds us that our life is now lived by faith in Him, transforming our hearts and purposes. You are God's handiwork, crafted intentionally (Ephesians 2:10), valuable beyond measure.

Surrender your brokenness to God and allow Him to restore your self-image based on His truth. Reflect on how your worth stands firm in Him, unshaken by past heartbreak, and ready for the beautiful plans He has prepared.

### Prayer for Today

Heavenly Father, thank You for making me a new creation in Christ. Help me to see myself through Your eyes — loved, redeemed, and purposeful. Heal the wounds that shake my identity and replace them with Your truth. Teach me to live by faith in Your Son who gave Himself completely for me. Guide me to embrace the good works You created me for and find joy in this season. Empower me to walk with confidence and peace, knowing my worth is secure in You alone. *In Jesus' name I pray.* Amen.















#### Your Verse

Jeremiah 29:11 – "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."
- Romans 8:28 "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him."







#### Devotional: Releasing Control to Embrace God's Plans

One of the hardest parts of healing is learning to let go of control and trust God's timing. Jeremiah 29:11 is a comforting reminder that God's plans for your life are good, even if they don't match your expectations. His timing is perfect, and His future for you is filled with hope.

Proverbs 3:5-6 encourages us to trust God completely, not relying on our understanding but submitting every part of our journey to Him. This trust allows God to guide our steps with wisdom and care. Even heartbreak becomes part of a larger divine story, as Romans 8:28 shows, where God works all things for our good.

Ask God to help you release fears, doubts, and impatience about your future relationships and life plans. Rest in His sovereignty and know that He sees the full picture while you move forward one step at a time.

3.	Describe what trusting God's timing looks like in your current season.

- Lamentations 3:22–23 "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."







#### Devotional: Walking Forward with Joyful Hope

Hope is the anchor for your soul as you heal and embrace your single life. Romans 15:13 offers a powerful prayer that God, the source of hope, will fill you with joy and peace so that your hope overflows through the Holy Spirit's power.

Psalm 147:3 beautifully reassures us that God heals broken hearts and binds wounds—a promise tailored directly to your journey. Each day brings new mercies (Lamentations 3:22–23), reminding you that God's faithfulness never fails, even when healing feels slow.

Allow yourself to trust that God's best is coming for your life, even if it looks different than you once imagined. Hold tightly to hope as a gift that sustains and empowers you toward a joyful future shaped by God's loving hand.
