#### Devotional: God Is Your Refuge in Troubling Times

Day 2:

#### Devotional: Know Yourself as God's Masterpiece Today

Your worth and dignity are sacred and unchangeable. Trauma often attacks our sense of self, whispering lies that can distort how we see ourselves. But God's Word shouts truth loud and clear: you are fearfully and wonderfully made.

Psalm 139 assures us that God intricately designed every part of who you are, even before birth. Your identity is rooted not in what has happened to you, but in the love and craftsmanship of your Creator. The eternal love mentioned in Jeremiah reminds you that God's kindness to you never fades. It is steady, sure, and everlasting.

As you meditate on this truth, gently ask the Holy Spirit to renew your mind with God's perspective, replacing any shame or self-condemnation. #### Devotional: Rest in Jesus and Receive Healing Today

#### Devotional: God Replaces Lost Years with New Hope

God promises restoration and redemption to those who believe. The devastation and loss caused by trauma can feel like years stolen away. Yet, Scripture reveals that God is able to restore what was broken and bring new life.

Joel's promise of repayment reminds us that no lost time or pain is wasted in God's economy. He can transform grief into growth and suffering into strength. Similarly, Isaiah urges us to release the past, not by forgetting but by trusting God to do a new work.

Being 'in Christ' invites you into a fresh identity—not defined by what hurt you but by what God is creating in you now. He is making you a new creation, healing your spirit and renewing your hope. This restoration process requires patience and grace toward yourself. Remember, God's power makes all things new through His love and mercy.

Today, embrace that the story of your life is still unfolding, and God is writing chapters of redemption into your narrative.

Day 5: W Embracing God's Unfailing Love

#### Devotional: Nothing Separates You from God's Love

At the core of healing is God's unfailing love. Trauma can cause feelings of rejection or abandonment, but Scripture assures us that nothing can separate us from God's love in Christ Jesus.

Romans powerfully declares that no hardship, fear, or shame can break God's connection with you. Zephaniah highlights God as a mighty warrior who is actively by your side to save and protect.

Jesus invites you into a love relationship that mirrors the perfect love that the Father has for Him. This love is patient, kind, and relentless. It does not give up or hold your past against you but covers you with grace and mercy.

Today, let God's perfect love be a balm for your soul. Soak in the truth that you are deeply loved with no conditions or limits. Let this love transform your heart, healing wounds and inspiring courage to step forward in faith.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Jeremiah 29:11 "I know the plans I have for you... plans to give you hope and a future."
- Lamentations 3:22–23 "His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning."







#### Devotional: Let God Fill You with Joy, Peace, and Hope

**Hope is the lifeline that keeps healing alive.** Trauma can dim the future, making hope feel distant or impossible. But the God of hope wishes to fill you with joy and peace as you lean fully on Him.

Jeremiah's promise reminds you that God's plans are filled with hope and a future beyond current trials. Similarly, Lamentations shows us that God's mercy is renewed daily, offering fresh grace and opportunity for healing.

Approach today with an open heart to receive this hope. Sometimes, hope grows slowly, through small moments of trust and faith. Let yourself be patient and gentle with your process.

Pray for God to cultivate a hopeful spirit within you, replacing despair with expectation of His goodness. Remember that peace is a fruit of trusting God's promises, not the absence of struggle. Your hope is anchored in a loving God who will never leave you or forsake you.
