#### Devotional: God's Nearness in Your Struggles

Day 2: O Trusting God for Healing

#### Devotional: God's Promise to Restore Health

Living with chronic UTIs often means longing deeply for healing. God's promise in **Jeremiah 30:17** speaks directly to this need: restoration and healing are His will for you. Healing does not always follow our timetable, but we can trust that God is working for our ultimate good.

#### Devotional: Finding Strength When You're Weak

The Apostle Paul calls God the source of all comfort in **2 Corinthians 1:3–4**, emphasizing that He understands your troubles intimately and offers divine consolation. Jesus, as described in **Hebrews 4:15**, fully empathizes with your weaknesses because He endured suffering too.

God's compassion is active and personal. He doesn't distance Himself from your pain but enters into it to bring comfort and hope. Open your heart to His loving kindness and allow His tender care to heal emotional wounds alongside physical ones.
