Day 3: **B** God's Peace That Calms Pain

Devotional: Receiving God's Unmatched Peace

Physical pain, such as that caused by gastritis, can disturb our peace deeply. Yet, Philippians 4:7 promises a supernatural peace that goes beyond human understanding, guarding our hearts and minds even amid suffering.
