#### Devotional: Faith Grows as We Listen Attentively

#### Devotional: Trusting the Spirit's Guiding Whisper

#### Devotional: Letting Scripture Illuminate Our Faith

God speaks powerfully through His Word. Psalm 119 beautifully describes Scripture as a lamp and light, illuminating our path when we walk by faith. In listening prayer, Scripture forms the foundation of how we hear and recognize God's voice.

When we read the Bible with attentive expectancy, God's truths become alive—teaching, correcting, and encouraging us. Our faith grows as we internalize these words and respond obediently. Moreover, God promises that as we seek Him, His voice will guide us clearly, often through Scripture's wisdom.

#### Devotional: Faith Flourishes in Expectant Prayer

**Listening prayer is marked by expectancy.** It's not simply speaking to God but being still and waiting on Him with confident hope that He will answer. James encourages us to ask God for wisdom generously, expecting Him to give.

When we practice listening prayer, we choose a posture of openness and patience, ready to receive God's counsel in resting silence. Faith grows as we learn not to rush or fill the silence with our own words but to trust that God's voice will come at the right time.

Try approaching prayer today with expectancy—believing God desires to speak. Use moments of stillness to quiet your mind and heart before the Lord. Notice how this waiting builds trust and intimacy with God, deepening your walk of faith.

#### Devotional: Trusting God Beyond Visible Proof

This kind of faith is strengthened when we recall Jesus as our example—the one who perfectly obeyed God's voice despite uncertainty. Trust calls us to lean on God's understanding, allowing His Word and Spirit to be our guide.

As you listen for God's voice, expect that sometimes He will call you to actions rooted in faith rather than certainty. This challenges us but also expands our spiritual sensitivity and dependence on God, making faith alive and transformative.
