Devotional: God's Divine Order Calls for Respect

Devotional: Humility Empowers Respectful Submission

Submission to authority springs from humility, an attitude that God cherishes and blesses. *James 4:6* reminds us that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. Respecting authority is impossible without surrendering pride and cultivating a humble heart.

Scripture warns that pride leads to destruction (*Proverbs 16:18*). When we resist authority out of arrogance or rebellion, we open ourselves to unnecessary troubles. Submission does not mean passivity but rather trusting God's governance and timing as we navigate life.

1 Peter 2:13–14 calls followers of Christ to submit for the Lord's sake, highlighting that our respect for authority is an act of worship and obedience to God, not merely to people.
