#### Devotional: Choose Integrity Despite Pressure

Integrity is the cornerstone of a God-honoring work ethic. Proverbs 10:9 highlights that people who walk in integrity have security, underscoring the spiritual and practical benefits of honesty. Our careers often face temptations to take easier dishonest shortcuts or compromise on values, but God calls us to a higher standard.

Psalm 15 describes the righteous as those who live blamelessly, reinforcing how God desires purity and faithfulness in our conduct. Jesus teaches in Luke 16:10 that trustworthiness over small matters leads to greater responsibilities. Thus, integrity in every detail matters.

Challenge yourself today: Are there areas where you feel tempted to cut corners? Seek God's help to live transparently and honorably, reflecting His righteousness in all that you do.

#### Devotional: Faithful Discipline Yields Lasting Rewards

Discipline and consistency form the backbone of a strong work ethic.

Proverbs 12:24 contrasts diligence with laziness, highlighting how persistent effort positions us for leadership and blessing. God wants us to steward our time and talents well.

Paul compares our spiritual race in 1 Corinthians 9:24, urging us to pursue goals zealously—this applies to our careers too. Galatians encourages perseverance, promising a harvest to those who do not give up.

Being disciplined also means developing routines, prioritizing, and resisting distractions or procrastination. As you reflect today, consider if consistency characterizes your work habits or if fatigue or apathy hinder your progress. Ask God to renew your stamina and zeal, so your career honors Him through faithful daily effort.
