## Devotional: Recognizing and Caring for True Need

## Devotional: Honoring Elders with Respect and Support

**Paul's instruction in 1 Timothy 5:17** emphasizes the importance of elders who lead the church faithfully. They deserve "double honor," a phrase that includes both respect for their spiritual authority and practical support for their needs. Elders dedicate their lives to teaching, shepherding, and modeling Christlike character, often bearing significant burdens silently and sacrificially.

The dignity here is twofold: elders should lead humbly and well, but the church community also bears responsibility to uphold them with honor and gratitude. This balance prevents burnout and establishes a culture where leadership flourishes under mutual respect.

Reflecting on this teaching calls us to examine how we view and treat church leaders and elders. Do we value their labor in word and deed? Do we support them emotionally, spiritually, and practically? Honoring them is not merely about protocol but a heartfelt acknowledgment of their vital role in God's mission.

As you close this study, ask God how He wants you to live out this care in your context. Whether through advocacy, practical acts of kindness, or willing service, each step matters deeply in building a family that reflects heaven on earth.
