Day 1: God's Vision for Life

Devotional: God's Spirit Brings Life to Dry Bones

The vision of the valley full of dry bones is a powerful metaphor for situations devoid of life, hope, and spirit. Ezekiel, a prophet during a time of exile and despair for Israel, is taken by God to witness the hopelessness of a nation represented by scattered bones. Yet, God's Spirit moves powerfully to bring restoration.

This reminds us that God does not ignore our valleys or the brokenness we face. Instead, He meets us there and reveals His power to transform even what appears dead. Life starts by God's presence and Spirit, and this vision invites us to expect change beyond what we see.

As you begin this study, consider God's invitation to bring life to your own 'valley'. His Spirit is active and ready to breathe hope into every situation.

Day 2: ➡ The Breath of God's Spirit

Devotional: God's Breath Transforms Despair to Life

The breath of God symbolizes life, renewal, and power. In Ezekiel 37:9, God commands the prophet to call upon the breath to come and give life to the slain bones. This breath is more than air — it is the essential life-giving Spirit from God. It reminds us that life and hope come only from Him.

Looking back to Genesis, where God breathed life into Adam, we see a beautiful parallel: God's Spirit animates both the first man and the valley of dry bones. The Spirit is both Creator and Restorer.

When we feel spiritually empty or disconnected, inviting God's breath means surrendering to His power to revive and sustain us. The same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, ready to bring hope and new beginnings.

In your own life, you may face ‘bones’ that defy logic or hope. God invites you to trust Him fully, leaning not on sight but on His truth. Your faith opens the door for God’s miraculous work.

Your dry bones—be they spiritual, emotional, or relational—are not beyond God's power. He can bring wholeness and restoration beyond your wildest imagination.
