Devotional: The Great Value of Loyalty in Friendship

Friendship is a treasure that God treasures deeply. Proverbs 18:24 reminds us that some friends may be unreliable, but there exists a friend who is closer than family—this points to Jesus, but also to the ideal quality in human friendships: loyalty and faithfulness. Devotional: Speak Truth with Love and Listen Well

Your Verse

Colossians 3:13 – 'Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.'

Supporting Scriptures

- *Matthew 18:21-22 – 'How many times shall I forgive my brother or sister? Up to seven times? Jesus answered, 'I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.'*
- *Romans 12:10 – 'Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.'*



Devotional: Forgiveness: The Heart of Faithful Friendship

Even the closest friendships experience hurt and disappointment. Colossians 3:13 commands us to bear with one another and forgive just as God has forgiven us. Forgiveness is not optional in faithful friendships—it's essential for healing and restoration.

Devotional: Serving Friends Through Life's Burdens

- *John 13:34 – 'A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.'*



Devotional: Enduring Love: The Core of Friendship
