Devotional: God's Promise of Complete Healing

Devotional: Relying on God to Renew Your Strength

Devotional: Caring for God's Temple Within You

Psalm 139 celebrates the wonder of God's creation in each detail of our physical being. Romans encourages us to present our bodies as offerings to God, even when frail or hurting. Valuing your body involves medical care, rest, and spiritual well-being.
