discover the beautiful assurance that comes from knowing we are truly saved. *May this study bring you peace, clarity, and joy in your walk with God.*  $\cLower$ 


















#### Your Verse

John 3:16 - "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Ephesians 2:8 "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—"
- Romans 10:9 "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."







#### Devotional: God's Love and the Gift of Salvation

Salvation begins with God's love. John 3:16 beautifully expresses the heart of salvation — God's incredible love for you and me. It is not based on our merit but on God's grace, freely given. Understanding this truth is the first step to knowing whether you are saved.

Day 2: W The Role of the Holy Spirit in Assurance

#### Your Verse

Romans 8:16 – "The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- John 14:26 "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."
- 2 Corinthians 1:22 "...God has also sealed us and given us the Spirit as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come."







Day 2: W The Role of the Holy Spirit in Assurance

#### Devotional: The Holy Spirit's Assurance of Salvation

God has given us the Holy Spirit as a helper and a guarantee. Romans 8:16 assures us that the Holy Spirit bears witness internally that we are God's children. This inner witness is a personal and spiritual confirmation of salvation.

The Spirit comforts, guides, and teaches us (John 14:26), shaping our understanding of God's truth. Moreover, 2 Corinthians 1:22 reminds us that the Spirit is like a seal or down payment, guaranteeing the fullness of salvation yet to come.

If you've wondered about assurance, tuning into the inner promptings of the Holy Spirit can bring peace. He convicts us gently and gives us confidence to know we belong to God. Today, listen quietly and thank God for this divine confirmation.

2.	What does it mean to you that the Spirit confirms you as God's child?
3.	How might you become more aware of the Spirit's guidance daily?









John 1:12 – "Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Galatians 2:16 "...a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ."
- Hebrews 11:1 "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."







#### Devotional: Faith Grants the Right to Be God's Child

Receiving Jesus and believing in His name grants us a new identity — children of God. John 1:12 reveals the intimate connection between faith and becoming part of God's family.

Salvation cannot be earned by trying to keep rules or performing good deeds, as Galatians 2:16 clarifies. It is through faith alone that we are justified — made right before God. This faith is not mere intellectual agreement but a deep trust and reliance on Jesus.

Hebrews 11:1 calls faith the assurance of things hoped for, giving us confidence even though we do not see what is to come. If you are hesitating or unsure, remember that faith invites you to trust beyond what you feel or understand, resting in God's promises. This day encourages you to examine your faith and its role in your assurance.

3.	How do you balance doubts with the call to trust God fully?

1.	Write a personal definition of faith based on Hebrews 11:1.

3.	List any barriers that make fully trusting Jesus difficult for you.

#### Your Verse

- Philippians 1:6 "He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."







Day 4:

#### Devotional: Relying on God's Promises for Assurance

God's Word offers us clear promises that are the foundation of our assurance. 1 John 5:13 was written so believers could *know* they have eternal life, not merely hope or guess.

Jesus promises eternal security in John 10:28, assuring us that once we are His, no one can take us away. This is a powerful truth that can calm fear and uncertainty.

Philippians 1:6 reminds us that God will faithfully complete His work in us, strengthening our confidence because salvation is both a position and a process. Let these promises sink deep into your heart today, helping you rest in God's unchanging faithfulness.

#### Your Verse

2 Corinthians 5:17 – "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Galatians 6:15 "Neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything; what counts is the new creation."
- Ephesians 4:22–24 "...put off your old self... and put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness."







#### Devotional: Embracing Your New Life in Christ

**Salvation brings transformation** — a new life in Christ. When God saves us, He makes us new creations as described in 2 Corinthians 5:17. This change is not just about belief but about a renewed heart and mind.

Neither rituals nor external practices can replace the internal transformation that God performs. Galatians 6:15 emphasizes that the new creation is what truly matters.

Ephesians 4:22–24 calls us to actively live out this new identity by letting go of old patterns and embracing righteousness and holiness. Today, consider how salvation manifests in your day–to–day life through growth and change.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- James 1:12 "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life."
- Philippians 3:14 "I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."







#### Devotional: Faith's Journey Requires Perseverance

**Salvation is a journey marked by perseverance.** Hebrews 12:1–2 encourages believers to continue steadfastly, fixing our eyes on Jesus, who exemplifies perfect faith.
