Day 1: V Strength Behind the Scenes

Day 1: ① Strength Behind the Scenes

Devotional: Courage and Strength Come from God

Leadership from behind the scenes begins with strength—strength not of muscle or position, but of spirit. Joshua was charged to lead Israel into an unknown future. God's command to him reminds us that courage comes from God's presence, not circumstances.

As a military spouse or family member, you face challenges that test your endurance. Unknown deployments, hardships, and uncertainties may cause fear or discouragement. Yet, God calls you to be strong and courageous.

Lean into the promise that *God is with you wherever you go*. When strength feels depleted, remember it is renewed as you place your hope in Him. Your role—though often unseen—is powerful and necessary in holding your family and community steady.
