#### Devotional: The Power of Seeking God First

This pride ultimately led to his downfall. His decision to enter the temple and perform duties meant for priests was an act of arrogance and disobedience that cost him dearly.

We are reminded in Scripture that pride precedes destruction, and God resists the proud. It is vital to remain vigilant in guarding our hearts against pride, especially when we experience success or recognition.

2 Chronicles 26:16–18 "Uzziah entered the temple to burn incense... Azariah the priest with eighty other priests confronted him and said, 'It is not right for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the Lord."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Exodus 30:9 "You must not offer incense on it to anyone other than the priests."
- Hebrews 12:10 "God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in his holiness."







Day 4: Crossing God's Boundaries

#### Devotional: Respect God's Boundaries and Receive His Blessings

King Uzziah's act of burning incense was more than a misguided ritual; it was a direct violation of God's established order. God had clearly defined who was permitted to perform certain sacred duties, and Uzziah overstepped this boundary, demonstrating arrogance and disrespect toward God's holiness.

His actions remind us that God's boundaries exist not to limit us, but to protect and guide us into holiness. When we choose to disregard these boundaries out of pride or presumption, we open ourselves up to consequences, including divine discipline.

God's discipline is an expression of His love, aiming to correct and restore us, not to punish arbitrarily. Like Uzziah, when we cross boundaries God has set, we need humility to accept correction and respond with repentance.

Today, reflect on whether you are respecting God's boundaries in your life and be ready to receive His loving discipline with a humble heart.

Day 5: Consequences of Disobedience

# Devotional: The Cost of Disobedience and Hope in Discipline

King Uzziah's disobedience brought about severe consequences: he was afflicted with leprosy and isolated from the Temple and his people. This physical and spiritual separation served as a lasting reminder of the cost of pride and rebellion against God.

While God is merciful, our choices have consequences, some immediate and others lifelong. Sin, even when hidden or seemingly small, can grow and negatively impact our lives, relationships, and ministries. Uzziah's story warns us that ignoring God's commands comes at a steep price.

Yet, God's discipline also opens the way for repentance and restoration. Though Uzziah lived with leprosy, God's hand remained upon his reign through the guidance of others. This shows us that even in chastening, God's presence and purpose remain.

Today, reflect on the impact of sin in your life and be encouraged that God's discipline seeks your healing and restoration.
