Remember: *Your story is sacred.* Your pain is real, but so is God's love and power to bring forth new life. This is a safe space to hold your soul tenderly and invite Christ's light back into your world.

#### Devotional: God Is Near to the Brokenhearted

He sees your brokenness and is actively close, offering salvation and comfort. The pain may feel isolating, but God's nearness promises you are never truly alone. In moments of deepest despair, you can turn to Him for refuge.

Isaiah 41:10 reassures us to cast aside fear. Despite darkness, God's steady presence sustains. Jesus' invitation in Matthew 11:28 calls the weary and burdened to find rest in Him — a rest that heals overwhelmed souls.

Allow yourself to feel what you feel today, knowing God is with you every step. He holds you with compassionate hands ready to bring hope.

Day 2: Healing through God's Compassion

Psalm 147:3 shows us that healing is at the heart of God's work: He tenderly binds wounds and restores broken hearts. The God of all comfort, as Paul reminds us in 2 Corinthians, is actively present to soothe pain and strengthen your spirit.

Embrace the reality that healing is a process nurtured by God's daily compassion. Let His faithfulness be your anchor as you walk forward in hope.

Consider how forgiveness — both given and received — might open a path toward healing. What chains can you begin to break today by inviting Christ's grace into your heart?

Isaiah reminds us that God renews the power of the weary. Psalm 46 promises God's refuge and strength as an ever-present help. When your spirit feels drained, these verses invite a divine replenishing.

The Lord's name is a strong tower, where the righteous find safety (Proverbs 18:10). Even when fear tries to overwhelm, God faithfully strengthens and protects you from harm (2 Thessalonians 3:3). His protection is both physical and spiritual, guarding your mind and soul as you heal.

Today, rest in God's protective presence. Trust that He is your refuge, sheltering your heart from further harm.

Zephaniah 3:17 reveals that God delights in you with singing and joy. Luke repeats that you are more precious than sparrows, creatures God watches carefully. You are infinitely loved and valued, completely known and cherished by your Creator.

Receive God's affirmation of your worth today. Let His love heal feelings of unworthiness and bring peace to your soul.

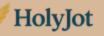
