## Devotional: God Sustains You Through Every Season

# Devotional: Inviting God's Peace Into Your Quiet Home

For the man living alone, the house can feel quiet, sometimes empty. Yet God offers a peace unlike anything the world can give—a peace that calms troubled hearts and banishes fear.

Jesus' words to His disciples remind us that peace is a gift. It does not depend on circumstances but comes from Him, reigning in our hearts even in solitude. Paul encourages believers to bring their anxieties before God in prayer so that His peace will guard them.

*Invite God's peace to fill your home today.* Pray in the rooms where you live, releasing worries to God. Imagine His peace settling deeply in your heart, turning loneliness into calm companionship.

3.	Reflect on how peace affects your relationships, even when living alone.

## Devotional: Trusting God's Wisdom in the Journey

**Living alone can bring many decisions to make without the immediate counsel of others.** What a comfort to know that God provides wisdom when we ask! Trusting in the Lord wholeheartedly and submitting to Him means inviting His guidance into every choice, big or small.

Proverbs reminds us that God will direct our paths, making them straight. We don't need to rely solely on our limited understanding or carry burdens alone. The psalmist shows a heart anchored in trust, unafraid of bad news because of God's faithfulness.

Seek God's wisdom today. When faced with decisions or uncertainties, ask Him to lead you clearly. Let this build your confidence in living alone, knowing God's guidance is unwavering.
