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Introduction

Welcome to this transformative 3-day Bible study plan designed especially for teens eager to make a difference through serving others. Devotional: Embracing a Humble Heart to Serve Others

Serving others begins with the right heart. Jesus modeled perfect humility and selflessness when He came to serve rather than to be served. As teens, the challenge is to adopt that same attitude in your daily life—whether at school, church, or home.

Sometimes serving feels inconvenient or uncomfortable. Maybe it means spending time helping set up chairs at church or standing with someone who's lonely at school. Yet, God calls you to do these things with a heart full of humility, choosing others' needs above your own.

Humility isn't thinking less of yourself; it's thinking of yourself less. When you serve with this kind of heart, you reflect Christ's love and bring light into the lives of others. Serving shapes your character, teaching patience, kindness, and compassion.

So today, ask yourself: Am I serving to be seen, or am I serving because I truly care? Your attitude matters more than the task. Let God transform your heart to serve with love and humility, just as Jesus did.
