Devotional: Embracing Your Identity as God's Light

Devotional: Honoring God by Working Wholeheartedly

Devotional: Finding Strength to Endure Workplace Challenges

Work pressure, opposition, or discouragement may test your faith. Yet, God calls such moments opportunities to grow perseverance and spiritual maturity. **Standing firm** means trusting God's strength, not our own, especially when workplace culture conflicts with our convictions.

Putting on God's armor daily—truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and the Word—equips us for unseen battles. These challenges can become powerful testimonies when met with grace rather than fear or retaliation.
