#### Devotional: Singleness as Kingdom Service

**Jesus chose a mission–focused life above all else.** Unlike societal expectations of marriage and family, Jesus' singleness was marked by complete dedication to God's will. In *John 6:38*, He reminds us that His purpose was to serve His Father's plan—not earthly interests.

Similarly, Paul affirms the value of singleness for undivided service to the Lord (*1 Corinthians 7:32*). This scripture highlights how singleness enables believers to focus fully on God's work without distraction. Jesus' life exemplifies this principle beautifully. He poured Himself out to teach, heal, and lead, showing us that singleness isn't a void but a powerful gift of freedom to serve.

Consider the phrase from Matthew 19:12, where Jesus acknowledges those who make themselves single for kingdom purposes. This echoes the intentionality we are invited to embrace today—choosing singleness as a sacred calling rather than a lesser option. Day 2: O Purpose and Freedom in Singleness

#### Devotional: Freedom to Serve and Trust God

Singleness invites freedom to pursue God wholeheartedly. Paul emphasizes in *1 Corinthians 7:34* the unique ability of single believers to devote themselves fully to the Lord, both body and spirit. Jesus exemplified this complete devotion throughout His earthly life, freely serving without the responsibilities that often come with marriage or family.

Jesus' mission, described in *Luke 4:18*, was about liberation and proclamation —bringing good news to the marginalized and freeing the oppressed. Singleness can empower us similarly, granting us mobility and focus to serve others with compassion and purpose.

Trusting God's guidance is crucial in this journey. *Proverbs 3:5–6* reminds us to place full confidence in the Lord, who will direct our paths straight. Singleness is not a season of uncertainty but one where God's leading can become clearer as we lean on Him more intensely.

Day 3: V Deepening Relationship with God

#### Devotional: Finding God in Solitude and Prayer

**Jesus' single life was deeply rooted in prayer and solitude.** In *Luke 5:16*, we see how He regularly withdrew to quiet places to connect intimately with the Father. Singleness provides a beautiful opportunity to cultivate such close communion with God without divided attention.

God calls us to stillness, as Psalm 46:10 encourages, to recognize His sovereign presence amid life's busyness. This can be especially meaningful for those who are single—to use this time to grow spiritually and listen to God's voice.

The promise in *James 4:8* assures us that as we draw near to Him, He draws near to us. This mutual closeness is a sweet blessing and a source of strength in times of solitude or longing.
