True holiness produces fruit that blesses others. Jesus compares believers to branches connected to the vine. When we remain in Him, His life flows through us, producing love, kindness, self-control, and more.

Fruit-bearing demonstrates a holy life's impact—transforming us and influencing the world. It's evidence of internal purity expressed externally.

Reflect on the fruit your life is bearing. How can you stay connected to Jesus to increase and deepen this fruitfulness?
