Day 1: **(**) God's Protection in Our Frailty

Your Verse

Psalm 91:1 – "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty."

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."
- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."







Day 1: **(**) God's Protection in Our Frailty

Devotional: Finding Refuge in God's Shelter

Living with allergic asthma often reminds us of our physical limitations and vulnerability. The sudden onset of symptoms can provoke fear and uncertainty. Yet, **Psalm 91:1** invites us to find rest "in the shadow of the Almighty," a beautiful picture of God's protection as a refuge where we find safety and peace.

Devotional: God's Nearness in Weakness and Breath

Allergic asthma can be exhausting, leaving you feeling brokenhearted or crushed in spirit. **Psalm 34:18** offers a tender reminder: God is not distant; He is close to those who are hurting. When breathing feels difficult or when you grapple with limitations, God draws near.

Jesus invites the weary—all who carry heavy burdens—to come to Him for rest (Matthew 11:28). This rest is deeper than physical relief; it refreshes the soul amidst trials. You don't have to carry your struggles alone or pretend everything is fine. Jesus welcomes your vulnerability and offers His grace freely.

Paul's words to the Corinthians resonate strongly here. In times of weakness, God's power shines brightest, showing that even in fragility there is strength through His sustaining grace (2 Corinthians 12:9). Your health journey is not wasted but made meaningful as you rely on God more deeply.

Today, lean into God's nearness and His promise to sustain you through every breath, even when it is difficult.

Devotional: Anchoring Our Hope in God's Plans

Chronic conditions like allergic asthma can sometimes cloud our outlook with worry or despair. But Scripture lights the way towards hope and peace. **Romans 15:13** prays for God to fill us with joy and peace as we place our trust in Him, reminding us that our hope is grounded not in circumstances but in God's faithful character.

Devotional: Honoring God by Caring for Our Bodies

God has entrusted you with a precious gift—your body, which is His temple. 1 Corinthians 6:19–20 calls us to honor God through how we care for ourselves, including managing allergic asthma responsibly. This means following medical advice, avoiding triggers when possible, and nurturing our physical health alongside our spiritual walk.

Trust and submission are key in this process. As **Proverbs 3:7–8** encourages, trusting God rather than leaning solely on our own understanding can guide us in making wise health decisions. He can direct our paths in healing and wellness.
