Day 1: De Foundation of True Wisdom

Devotional: Start with God: The Root of Wisdom

Devotional: Protect Your Inner World With Peace

Singleness brings unique emotional challenges, including loneliness, comparisons, and longing. Paul's words in Philippians remind us that God offers supernatural peace that protects both heart and mind. This peace acts as a shield against fears and doubts.

Guarding your heart means protecting your inner self from harmful thoughts or influences that could distract or discourage you. Proverbs 4:23 warns us that the condition of the heart affects all areas of life. Your thoughts influence your feelings, actions, and spiritual health.

Practically, this means being intentional about what you allow to fill your mind — social media, conversations, music, and your own self-talk. You have the stewardship to choose what nurtures you toward peace and wisdom.

Devotional: Learning to Embrace Your Season Fully

Devotional: Let Christ's Peace Rule Your Heart

Peace is a powerful result of living wisely in singleness. Paul encourages believers to let Christ's peace take full control of their hearts. This peace is not dependent on external circumstances or relationships but on the unchanging nature of God's love.

In singleness, you may face loneliness or uncertainty, but God's peace transcends these feelings and anchors your soul. It reassures you that you are deeply loved and secure in God's plans. Unlike worldly peace which is fleeting and conditional, Christ's peace is steadfast and transformative.
