Your Verse

Psalm 92:1 NIV – "It is good to praise the LORD and make music to your name, O Most High,"

Supporting Scriptures

- *1 Thessalonians 5:18 – "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."*
- *Colossians 3:17 – "And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."*



Devotional: The Power of Beginning with Thanks

Starting our journey with the psalmist's declaration, we see the power of choosing gratitude at the start of each day. Psalm 92:1 reminds us it is good — indeed, fitting — to praise God and ascribe glory to Him. But what makes this so important? - *Isaiah 12:5 – "Sing to the LORD, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world."*



Devotional: Joy in Celebrating God's Faithfulness

Day 3: 🌿 Rooted and Flourishing in Thanks



Your Verse

Psalm 92:12-13 NIV – "The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon; planted in the house of the LORD, they will flourish in the courts of our God."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Jeremiah 17:7-8 – "But blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him. They will be like a tree planted by the water..."*
- *Colossians 2:6-7 – "...rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness."*



Devotional: Growing Strong Through Thankful Living

In closing our study of Psalm 92, we encounter a vivid picture of those who live with hearts full of thanks—the righteous flourishing. The imagery of trees growing strong, deeply rooted and thriving, reminds us that thanksgiving is not just an attitude but a source of spiritual vitality.

Being "planted in the house of the LORD" means a deep connection to God that provides nourishment and stability. Just as trees need roots to flourish, our hearts need to be firmly grounded in God's presence and truth. Jeremiah 17:7-8 echoes this, emphasizing that trust in the Lord brings blessing and resilience.

Colossians 2:6-7 highlights that as we walk in faith, being "rooted and built up in Him," thankfulness naturally overflows from us. It is evidence of a living relationship with Christ, producing growth and peace.

As you reflect today, consider how a heart of thanksgiving strengthens your spiritual life and enables you to thrive amid any circumstance.
