Living with Integrity



This 7-day study helps young men live with honesty, purity, and strength in secret and in public —because true integrity is who you are when no one's watching.





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Introduction

Integrity is one of the most powerful and rare character traits a man can have. In a world where shortcuts are praised and secrets are easily hidden, it's tempting to fake it on the outside while quietly crumbling on the inside. Many young men today face overwhelming pressure to *look right* while struggling to *be right*. The result? Split lives. One version for others—and one hidden in the dark.

But God never called you to be impressive. He called you to be **honest**, **pure**, and **whole**. Integrity doesn't mean you're perfect—it means you're the same person in the light and in the dark. It's about choosing character over comfort, truth over convenience, and Jesus over reputation.

This study is for young men who want to become trustworthy in every part of their life—from their friendships, online choices, and dating relationships to their schoolwork, jobs, and spiritual walk. You'll be challenged to take ownership of who you are, even when no one is watching. God is building men of honor in secret places. That includes you.

Devotional: What You Hide in Your Heart Will Eventually Show Up in Your Life

Many guys try to clean up their behavior without dealing with what's going on inside. But you can't live with integrity outwardly if you're full of compromise inwardly. Eventually, what's in your heart will **leak out**—in your words, your choices, your habits.

The Bible teaches us to **guard our hearts** like treasure. That means being intentional about what you let into your life: the media you consume, the people you admire, the thoughts you dwell on. Integrity flows from a heart that is **daily surrendered to God**.

Don't treat your heart like a trash bin. Treat it like sacred ground. When your heart is aligned with Christ, integrity becomes natural—not forced.

Prayer for Today

Lord, You know what's in my heart. You see what I allow in, what I obsess over, and what I try to bury. Cleanse my heart from anything that doesn't honor You. Make me sensitive to what corrupts my character. Teach me to guard my heart like treasure and fill it with things that build integrity—not break it.

Devotional: Private Integrity Is the Foundation for Public Strength

Integrity isn't measured in front of others—it's revealed **when you're alone.** When no one is watching. When you're in your room, on your phone, or lying in bed. That's where integrity is born—or broken.

God wants to meet you in those quiet places. David said, "I will conduct the affairs of my house with a blameless heart." That means his **private life** matched his public worship. Can you say the same?

Who are you when nobody sees you? That's the real you. But the good news is, that's also where Jesus meets you—not with shame, but with love and transformation.

Devotional: You Can't Be Two People Forever

Living a double life is exhausting. Pretending to be strong while secretly struggling. Acting holy around others but indulging in sin when you're alone. Sooner or later, the weight of living two lives will crush you—or expose you.

Jesus said you can't serve two masters. Eventually, you'll love one and resent the other. You can't walk toward God while clinging to sin. Integrity means picking a side—and staying there.

It's time to stop switching masks. When you try to live in both the light and the dark, the darkness always wins. But when you choose truth, even when it's hard, **God builds strength into your soul** that can't be shaken.

Devotional: A Man of Integrity Speaks the Truth— Even When It's Hard

Every time you lie—whether it's a half-truth, an excuse, or something you cover up—you chip away at your character. Lies always come with chains. But truth sets you free.

Honesty is the foundation of trust. When you're honest, people know they can rely on you. More importantly, **God delights in your honesty.** He honors those who speak the truth with humility and courage.

Start small if you need to. Tell the truth when you mess up. Admit when you're struggling. Choose to speak with honesty, even when it's uncomfortable. That's how you become a man people can trust—and a man God can use.

Prayer for Today

God, I want to be trustworthy. I want people to know that my word means something. But I admit I've taken the easy way out. I've lied to protect myself. I've hidden behind excuses. Today, I choose the path of honesty. Even when it costs me something, let me be a man who tells the truth and lives in the light. **Amen.**

Devotional: Let Your Character Speak Louder Than Your Age

You don't need to be older to be respected—you need to be **consistent**. Young men with integrity stand out because they walk in honor, especially in how they treat others.

How do you talk to your friends? Do you show respect to authority? How do you treat women? Do your relationships reflect Christ or compromise? These questions reveal your integrity in action.

Integrity in relationships means choosing purity over pressure, kindness over sarcasm, and loyalty over gossip. It means showing up with truth and love—even when it's inconvenient. God's calling you to be the **example**, not the exception.

Devotional: Live for the Applause of Heaven, Not the Approval of Man

When all is said and done, integrity is not about what others think—it's about who you are before God. One day, every secret will be revealed, every hidden habit exposed. What will matter is whether you were the same man in the quiet as you were in public.

God is not looking for perfection. He's looking for **realness**. He delights in the one who walks in truth—not because it's easy, but because it honors Him. The man of integrity doesn't perform for people—he lives for God.

Let today be a defining moment. Don't fake it anymore. Don't settle for surface-level faith. Choose to be whole. The same on Sunday as you are on Saturday night. The same at church, school, home, and online. This is integrity—and God promises it leads to peace, security, and closeness with Him.

Amen.



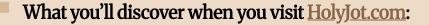




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
