#### Devotional: Faith Comes Alive Through Action

**Faith must be active** to truly reflect God's love in the world. It's easy to think of faith as something private or only practiced on Sundays, but James reminds us that faith without action is dead. As a teen, you often live in spaces where people notice your character and choices daily—at school, on social media, with friends and family.

Being the Church means your faith doesn't stop when you leave the building. When you choose kindness, stand up against bullying, or help someone struggling, you're living out God's love. Let your faith make a real, visible difference by turning belief into action, showing others the hope and light Jesus offers.
