Devotional: Embracing God's Unfailing Love

Supporting Scriptures

- Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord.







Devotional: Discovering God's Unique Purpose for You

Being chosen by God means that you have a unique purpose. Ephesians 2:10 declares that you are God's handiwork, created intentionally for good works that He prepared for you beforehand. When you feel worthless, remembering your divine purpose can anchor your identity.

Devotional: Recognizing God's Masterpiece in You
