# Devotional: Wholehearted Love Begins With Our Heart

#### Devotional: Prioritizing God Above All Else

Loving God isn't just about feelings; it's about the choices we make every day. Jesus teaches that we are to seek God's kingdom first—putting Him before everything else, including school, friends, and our own desires.

As a teen, decisions come every moment—from what you focus on online, to how you spend your free time, to the values you live by. *Choosing to put God first means choosing what pleases Him over what pleases the world or even ourselves.*

#### Devotional: Love Expressed in Obedience and Action

True love for God is more than words or feelings—it's shown in obedience. Jesus makes it clear that loving Him means keeping His commands. This doesn't mean a list of boring rules but living in a way that reflects His character and love.

As a teen, this can look like being kind even when it's hard, choosing honesty over cheat sheets, standing up for what is right, or serving others willingly. *Every choice to follow God's ways is an expression of your love for Him.* 

Sometimes love requires sacrifice, and obeying God might mean saying no to things that don't honor Him. But His commands are not a burden; they lead to a life filled with freedom, peace, and joy.

Reflect on your daily actions—are they showing your love for God? Ask Him to empower you to live obediently and to love Him not just by words but by your lifestyle.
