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Introduction

Day 2: Communication About Money

Devotional: The Power of Honest Money Conversations

Effective money management in marriage requires open, honest, and respectful **communication**. Proverbs 15:22 reminds us that plans succeed when we seek counsel, including from those closest to us—our spouse.

Too often financial struggles arise because couples avoid discussing money out of fear or misunderstanding. Instead, God calls us to communicate with patience and kindness, listening before speaking as James instructs.

Today, spend time intentionally conversing with your spouse about your financial hopes and challenges. Pray for God to guide your words and open your hearts to understanding.

Devotional: Diligent Planning Brings Financial Peace

Preparation and diligent planning are key to stewarding resources wisely. Proverbs 21:5 instructs us that careful plans lead to profit, while haste often results in loss. This principle applies powerfully in marriage when managing finances.

Jesus illustrates the importance of budgeting by highlighting the need to count costs before building (Luke 14:28). Having a budget helps couples align expectations, avoid unnecessary debt, and steward resources effectively.

Creating a financial plan together can eliminate anxiety and build confidence. It also fosters teamwork, enabling you to pursue financial goals such as saving for a home, education, or ministry opportunities.

Reflect on your current financial planning and commit to working with your spouse to create or revise a budget that honors God, meets your needs, and prepares for the future responsibly.

Supporting Scriptures

- Malachi 3:10 "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse...and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven."







Devotional: Giving with Joy Builds Unity and Faith

True stewardship includes *generosity*. In marriage, giving blesses not only the receiver but also the giver and the relationship itself. God calls us to give cheerfully and faithfully, trusting Him to provide abundantly.

2 Corinthians 9:7 highlights the heart attitude behind giving—it's not about obligation, but joyful willingness. Acts 20:35 reminds us that blessing flows more powerfully when we give than when we receive.

Discuss with your spouse how generosity fits into your financial stewardship. Explore ways you can give to your church, community, and those in need as a couple. Experiencing the joy of giving together builds unity and deepens your faith.

Remember, God promises to bless those who honor Him with their resources (Malachi 3:10). Trusting in His provision frees you to give with open hearts.
