Devotional: Loving Each Other with Christlike Sacrifice

Jesus' sacrificial love is the ultimate example for marriage. In Ephesians, husbands are called to love their wives as Christ loved the church — with selflessness and total commitment. This kind of love isn't just for husbands; it models the depth of care and sacrifice both partners should embody.

Self-giving love builds trust, security, and abundance in the marital relationship and positions your family as a beacon of God's love. It encourages forgiveness, patience, and service to one another, which flows naturally into your wider family and community.

Reflect on ways you can demonstrate Christlike love in your marriage. How can you practice sacrificial kindness and patience today to strengthen your family's testimony?

Devotional: Choosing Forgiveness to Preserve Unity

Forgiveness and grace are vital to maintaining unity in marriage. No marriage is perfect; conflicts and misunderstandings will come. Paul urges couples to bear with one another, demonstrating patience and forgiveness as an expression of love.

Forgiveness breaks down walls of bitterness and resentment, allowing healing and renewed closeness. When grace leads your interactions, your marriage becomes a safe refuge that models God's mercy to others.

Take time today to evaluate if unforgiveness or pride is hindering your unity. Ask God for the grace to forgive, and consider ways to extend patience and humility to your spouse.
