Devotional: Start with Patient, Kind Love

Devotional: Demonstrating God's Oneness

Jesus prayed for unity among His followers, that they might be one as He and the Father are one. Marriage is a beautiful microcosm of this divine unity. When husbands and wives are united in purpose, heart, and spirit, they reflect the oneness God desires for His people.

Such unity becomes a powerful testimony to the watching world. Outside observers notice when couples handle disagreements with grace, share a common vision, and work together. This unity invites others to seek the God who makes it possible.

Devotional: The Power of Forgiveness

Forgiveness is a cornerstone of any marriage that reflects God's grace. We all make mistakes and can hurt those we love, but through forgiveness, healing happens and relationships grow stronger. Colossians reminds us to bear with one another and forgive as Christ forgave us.

When forgiveness flows freely in marriage, it becomes a living witness of God's mercy. It dismantles bitterness and resentment and replaces them with peace and restoration.

Consider the times when you found it difficult to forgive and how God's grace carried you through. Embracing forgiveness daily opens the door for your marriage to be a testimony to others of Christ's redeeming love.
