#### Devotional: God's Design: Unity in Marriage

#### Devotional: Strengthening Marriage through Prayer

#### Devotional: The Power of Honest Communication

#### Emotional honesty is vital to building trust and intimacy in marriage.

Ephesians reminds us to speak truthfully, for deception or withholding feelings fracture unity. When couples foster safe environments where honest emotions are expressed with love and respect, they enhance their connection deeply.

Emotions are powerful communicators but must be managed with wisdom and kindness. James instructs us to be quick to listen and slow to anger, principles that protect relationships from unnecessary hurt and misunderstanding. Wise communication can heal wounds rather than inflict new ones.

Today, reflect on how you and your spouse practice emotional honesty. Where might fear or impatience be blocking openness? Invite the Holy Spirit to empower your words and responses so that truth can promote healing and deepen your bond.
