Day 1: 💑 Foundations of Marriage and Contentment

Your Verse

Hebrews 13:4 - "Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral."

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 Timothy 6:6 "But godliness with contentment is great gain."
- Proverbs 15:16 "Better a little with the fear of the LORD than great wealth with turmoil."

Devotional: Honoring Marriage Through Contentment

Marriage is a sacred covenant, one that requires honoring God and each other. *Contentment* within marriage is a deep treasure — it guards against the corrosion of greed and dissatisfaction that can damage relationships.

Hebrews 13:4 reminds us of the importance of purity and respect in marriage. Yet, contentment goes beyond behavior; it speaks to the heart's posture toward what we have and whom we share life with. Our culture often glorifies accumulation of wealth, but true gain is found in godliness and contentment (1 Timothy 6:6).

Reflect on the value of a little with the fear of the Lord versus great wealth accompanied by turmoil (Proverbs 15:16). This verse challenges us to examine what brings not just material abundance but peace and joy in our homes.

Today, embrace the foundation of marriage as a space where contentment cultivates honor, purity, and God-centered joy, protecting your union from the temptation to pursue wealth at the expense of intimacy.

- Proverbs 28:25 "The greedy stir up conflict, but those who trust in the LORD will prosper."







Day 2: 😽 Resisting Greed in Marriage

Devotional: Guarding Marriage Against Greed

Greed is a subtle yet destructive force that can creep into marriages, causing conflict and discontentment. Luke 12:15 warns us that life's true value is not measured by possessions but by the richness of relationships and faith.

When partners pursue wealth excessively, it can create division and frustration. Ecclesiastes 5:10 highlights the insatiable nature of greed — no matter how much we have, it is never enough. This endless chase diminishes joy and peace.

Proverbs 28:25 points out that greed stirs up conflict, while trust in the Lord leads to true prosperity. Marriages that fix their hope on God experience peace that transcends circumstances.

Today, examine your heart for places where greed may be influencing your attitudes or actions. Pray together for strength to resist, and cultivate trust in God's provision as the foundation of your marriage.

Devotional: Power of Thanksgiving in Union

Gratitude is a powerful antidote to greed and discontentment, especially in marriage. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 encourages us to give thanks in all circumstances, a practice that nurtures contentment and deepens connection.

Colossians 3:15 speaks to allowing the peace of Christ to rule in our hearts as we cultivate thankfulness — an essential ingredient for harmony in marriage. Psalm 107:1 reminds us that God's enduring love is the ultimate reason for our gratitude.

Reflect together on the blessings in your marriage, large and small. Gratitude shifts perspective, fostering joy and resilience, even during challenging seasons. By making thanksgiving a habit, your marriage grows rooted in God's goodness rather than material gain.

Today, foster a spirit of appreciation for your spouse and the gift of your union, thanking God for His faithfulness.

Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."
- Ecclesiastes 7:12 "Wisdom preserves those who have it."







Devotional: Seeking God's Wisdom in Marriage

In marriage, decisions about finances and priorities can either build or damage the relationship. **Wisdom** is more precious than wealth because it guides us to make choices that honor God and protect our union.

Proverbs 3:13 declares a blessing on those who seek and find wisdom, while James 1:5 encourages us to ask God for wisdom generously. Ecclesiastes 7:12 reminds us that wisdom preserves and protects.

When couples prioritize wisdom over the pursuit of more money, they avoid unnecessary conflicts and align their goals with God's purposes. Today, seek God's guidance together about your choices and ask for understanding that strengthens your marriage.

- 2 Corinthians 9:7 "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."
- Matthew 6:21 "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."







Devotional: Generosity Builds Marital Unity

Generosity within marriage nurtures unity and counters the selfishness greed fosters. Acts 20:35 reminds us of the blessing in giving, emphasizing that selflessness brings joy and strengthens relationships.

2 Corinthians 9:7 highlights that giving should be cheerful and heartfelt, not forced. When couples cultivate generosity together, their hearts grow aligned toward God's purposes.

Matthew 6:21 calls us to consider where our treasure is, because that is where our hearts dwell. When our treasure is in love and giving, our marriages flourish. Today, look for ways to practice generosity in your marriage, whether through time, resources, or encouragement.

Your Verse

- Philippians 4:11 "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances."

Devotional: Finding Contentment Without Comparison

Comparison is a hidden threat that breeds dissatisfaction and envy, which can harm marriage intimacy. Galatians 6:4 encourages self-examination without comparison to others.

2 Corinthians 10:12 warns about the dangers of measuring ourselves against others, which can lead to pride or discouragement. Instead, Philippians 4:11 reveals the secret of true contentment — learning to be satisfied regardless of circumstances.

As a couple, guarding your hearts against comparison strengthens gratitude and focus on your unique journey. Today, resist the pull to measure your marriage by others' standards, and celebrate the grace God is working in your union.
