# Devotional: God's Love: The Ultimate Marital Foundation

The poetry of Song of Solomon reminds us of the delight and exclusivity that love brings: belonging wholly to one another. To rekindle romance, couples must return to these roots of love that is patient, kind, and deeply personal. Love is not merely a feeling but an active pursuit of the other's good.

**Reflection:** What aspects of Christ's love inspire you most in your marriage? How can you demonstrate that love tangibly to your spouse today? Rekindling romance begins by committing to love as God intended — consistently and wholeheartedly.

# Devotional: Inviting God Into Your Marriage Intimately

Joshua's declaration to serve the Lord emphasizes the choice couples make daily — to put God first as a family. Rekindling romance includes inviting God into your marriage, creating a spiritual intimacy that surpasses emotions and circumstances.
