Devotional: Created in God's Image with Creative Purpose

Day 2: 7 Courage to Create with Integrity

Micah 6:8 sums up God's expectations: justice, mercy, and humility before Him. Rooting your identity and creativity in Christ empowers you to live this out authentically.

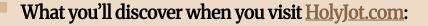




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
